Art Shed Demo

Vikki and Robyn attended the Art Shed Demo this month which was with artist Jo Underhill.

Jo is inspired by the beauty of nature, natural forms and microscopic views. She focuses mostly on colour and mark making working in multiple layers and mediums.

Jo's art approach is experimental, spontaneous and intuitive. Nothing about her artmaking is pre-planned or prescribed; everything is free and flexible. She doesn't follow restrictive rules or put limitations on her art practice. Jo's images are unique and quirky; they 'emerge' onto the canvas from a synthesis of her memories, observations, and dreams. Her finished pieces are highly evocative, spiritual, and elegant.

Be sure to book into her workshop in October at LAA Art Studio.

Guest Speaker August Meeting

Tianni from School Art Supplies represented both School Art Supplies and also Art Shed. She congratulated LAA for having a strong active membership and spoke of the Qld Art Teacher's Association which is struggling with low membership and very low commitment from members. Tianni said it was important for kids and adults to have the opportunity to play and experiment with art products and techniques so they can have 'happy accidents'. She said it was important for artists to be aware of the quality of art materials and the diverse characteristics of new and existing materials. Manny from Art Shed is a medical GP, and he promotes art because of the positive effects on good health

Conditions of Entry

1. Entry is only open to current financial members of Logan Artists Association Inc.
2. A limit of two (2) entries per artist.
3. Entry Fee is \$10 per entry if the artist is transporting the paintings to and from the gallery. If LAA transport is required, entry fee is \$15 per entry.
4. Closing Date for entries is **Saturday 1st October 2011**.
5. Choice of medium, and style are flexible. Work must be of the standard to be displayed in a gallery.
6. The size of the work must not exceed 100cm x 100cm (including frames). Pottery and sculpture works to be of suitable size and weight to display on LAA plinths.
7. To be eligible artworks must be the original work of the artist and must not have been previously exhibited. The work must have been completed within the last 12 months (from Oct 2010).
8. Copies of other people's work taken from prints, etchings, calendars, books, magazines, postcards or newspapers will not be accepted.
9. Titles and prices are to remain the same as on the entry form for the duration of the exhibition. Artworks must be clearly marked on the back with artist's Name, Title, Medium, & Price.
10. All works will be offered for sale unless labelled Not For Sale (NFS). A commission of 20% will be retained by the LAA on the sale of any works. All exhibits are to remain on display until the close of the exhibition.
11. Each artist is responsible for delivery to and pick up from the exhibition, unless arrangements are made for LAA transport for artwork to and from gallery.
12. If LAA transport is being used, all artwork must be delivered to LAA, 27 Coral St, Loganlea by 10am on Wednesday 19th October. If artist is delivering the artwork to the Circle Gallery, artwork is to be delivered to 274 Montague Rd, West End between 11am-2pm on Wednesday 19 October, 2011.
13. If artist is collecting their artwork from the Circle Gallery, artwork is to be collected between 10am-noon on Wednesday 26th October. If LAA transport is being used, artwork is to be collected from LAA Art Studio between 10-noon on Friday 28th October 2011. Any uncollected works will become the property of the LAA and will be donated to charity.
14. All care will be taken with exhibits, but LAA Inc accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
15. Exhibits should be suitably framed or finished for hanging with D rings and wire attached. No WET paint. Artworks not presented correctly cannot be exhibited.
16. LAA reserves the right not to hang paintings or display works that do not comply with the above conditions or to withhold any works from display considered at their discretion to be non-acceptable for any reason. Some artwork may be acceptable but not displayed due to availability of gallery space.
17. Because artist's information is often requested, a biography for public reference may be included with the entry form. This will be displayed in a folder at reception. Please restrict to one A4 sheet.
18. No entries accepted without payment or proof of EFT deposit and completed entry slip.
